Anyone wanting to remove their name from the May 4 Municipal Ballot must do so by 5 pm.



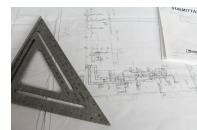
March 23, 8 am - noon Spring Trash Bash

2019 Municipal Elections

Staggered elections are held the first Saturday in May each year. In the even years, three Council members are on the ballot; in the odd years, two Council members and the Mayor are on the ballot.

Early voting is handled by Montgomery County. During the early voting period, any registered voter in Shenandoah may vote at any open Montgomery County early polling place. On Election Day, voters may only vote in their respective precincts. For Shenandoah, Election Day voting is in the Municipal Complex Council Chambers. [Voting location information](#)

Positions up for election on May 4 are:
Position 2, currently held by Ted Fletcher,
Position 3, currently held by Byron Bevers, and
Position 4, currently held by Charlie Bradt.

Signup for the ballot will run from January 16 through February 15. Signup will be through the City Secretary's office; all completed applications must be turned in by 5 pm February 15.

- Feb. 15 - last day to file for a ballot position
- Feb. 22 - last day to withdraw a name
- Apr. 4 - last day to register to vote in the election
- Apr. 22 - first day of early voting
- Apr. 23 - last day to apply for ballot by mail
- Apr. 30 - last day of early voting
- May 4 - Municipal Election Day
